

About the **GRE**® Subject Tests

The GRE® Subject Tests did not change with the launch of the GRE® revised General Test.

What Are the Subject Tests?

The GRE Subject Tests emphasize knowledge and skill level in a specific area. In addition to the GRE revised General Test, Subject Tests may or may not be required by universities.

Who Takes Them and Why?

Prospective graduate school applicants take the Subject Tests. GRE scores are used by admissions or fellowship panels to supplement undergraduate records, letters of recommendation and other qualifications for graduate study.

The scores provide common measures for comparing the qualifications of applicants and aid in the evaluation of grades and recommendations. Some Subject Tests yield subscores that can indicate the strengths and weaknesses in an individual student's preparation and may also be useful for guidance and placement purposes.

Each Subject Test is intended for students who have extensive background in one of these seven disciplines:

	Biochemistry, Cell and Molecular Biology

	<u>Literature in English</u>
	<u>Mathematics</u>
	<u>Physics</u>
	<u>Psychology</u>

Who Accepts Them?

GRE Subject Test scores are accepted by thousands of graduate schools, including individual departments or divisions within these schools. Although the scores may not be a requirement for admission to a particular program, admissions committees are likely to consider the scores if they are submitted. It's best to contact the admissions office or department you're interested in and see exactly what they're looking for.
