- Students in the 10th or 11th grade
- Students in the top 10% of their class for the last three years in school
- Students committed to pursuing a Bachelor's degree in the U.S.
- Students active in sports, community projects and/or the arts are preferred
- Students who are mature, flexible and can adapt to academic life in the U.S.
- Students who cannot afford to study in the U.S. without a scholarship
- Students who are committed to the demanding application process and requirements of the DKSSF program



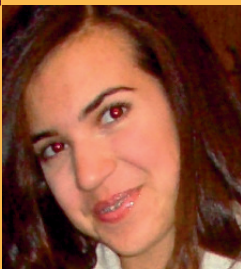

The application and all supporting documents must be submitted to the AMIDEAST office before this date.

How Do I Apply?

For Students in the 10th Grade or “Seconde”

Download and complete the DKSSF application, and submit it to AMIDEAST with the documents listed below:

- Official school transcripts for 8th, 9th (*brevet*), and 10th (*seconde*) grades and the official *brevet* exam grades
- Copies of certificates of awards, honors, achievements, community service, work experience, etc.
- Copies of published work, if any (poetry, writing, music, drawings)

For Students in the 11th Grade or “Premiere”

Download and complete the DKSSF application, and submit it to AMIDEAST with the documents listed below:

- Official school transcripts for 9th (*brevet*), 10th (*seconde*) and 11th (*premiere*) grades
- A copy of the SAT I and SAT II scores (*If available*)
- A copy of the iBT TOEFL score or the iTP TOEFL exam (*If available*)
- Copies of certificates of awards, honors, achievements, community service, work experience, etc.
- Copies of published work, if any (poetry, writing, music, drawings)

A Note to Students and Parents

By applying, you are indicating your commitment to work hard to meet the many deadlines required to win admissions and scholarships from U.S. universities. You must commit yourself 100% to the DKSSF program and the intensive work and time requirements.

Final selection will be made on the basis of the written application and interviews of selected students.

The criteria for selection will be based both on academic excellence and personal achievement.
