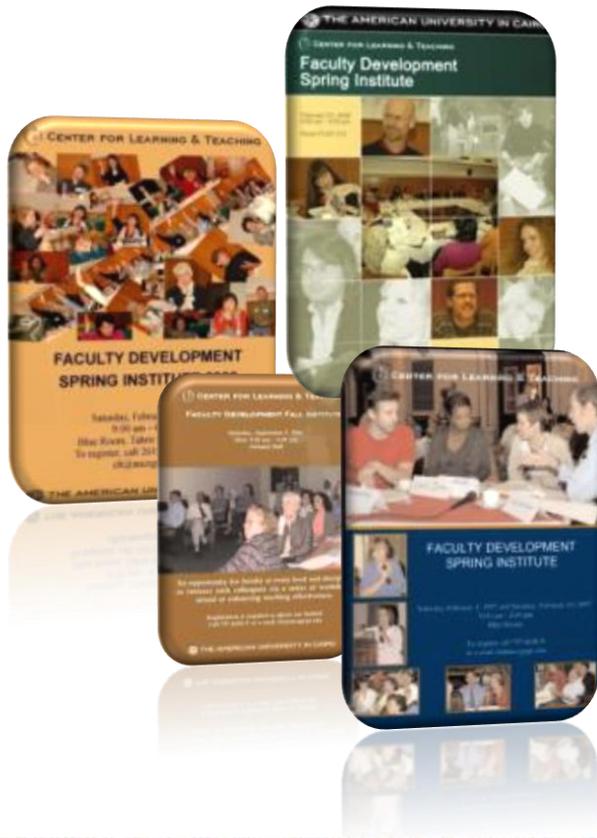

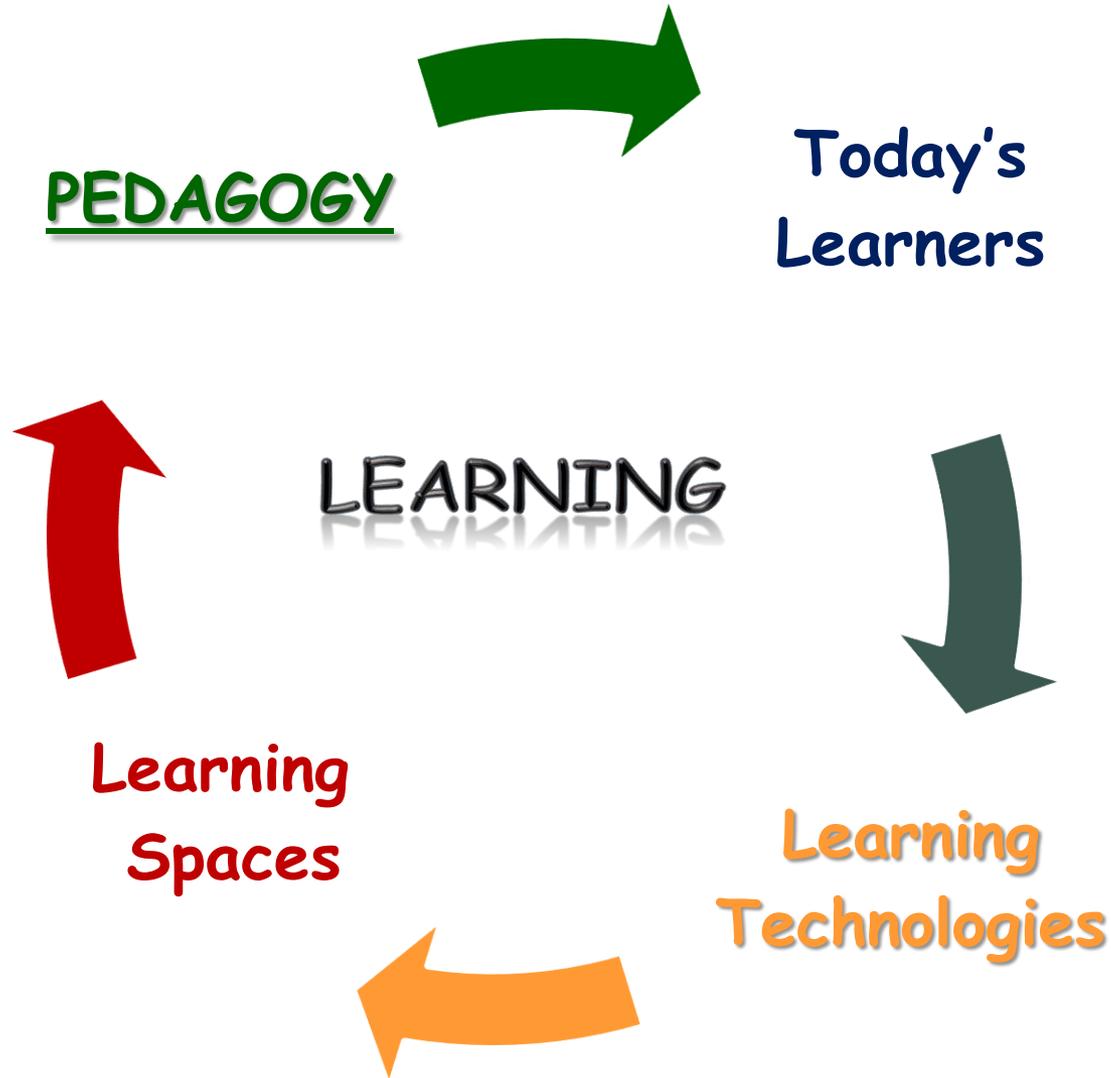

# Different Teaching and Learning Landscape



In some ways, our role as faculty  
has remained the same...

- Role of Faculty is still to
  - Guide the learning experience
  - Facilitate student's relationship with the discipline

# ...and in others it has changed

- Rethink Learning and Teaching
  - What has worked in the past may no longer be helpful or reliable
- Create new partnerships with specialists and peers

# Current trends in teaching and learning\*

- Course [and class] time is devoted to **discovery-based learning** over traditional lecture modes
- Teaching emphasis has moved away from memorizing facts towards **finding, evaluating and using information**
- "**Research**" and "**teaching**" are perceived as mutually enhancing rather than antithetical.

# Current trends in teaching and learning\*

- New teaching and learning styles incorporate **collaborative work** in diverse teams or groups.
- Course **content** is **publicly accessible** and shared beyond the members of an individual course

# Current trends in teaching and learning\*

- The **instructor** is perceived as a **partner in a learning community** rather than as a sole entrepreneur.
- **Assessment** is multilevel and complex

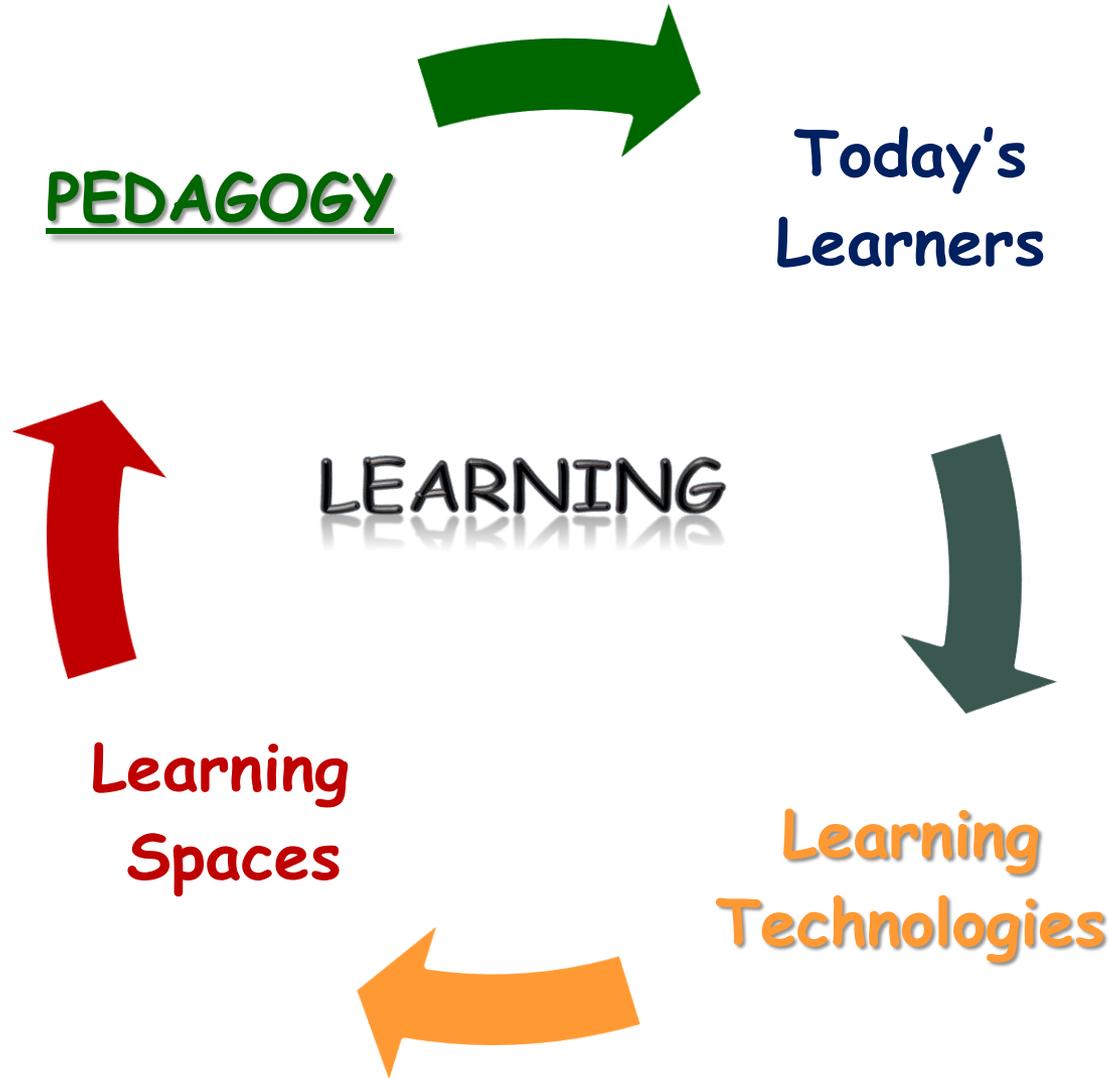
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# Current trends in teaching and learning\*

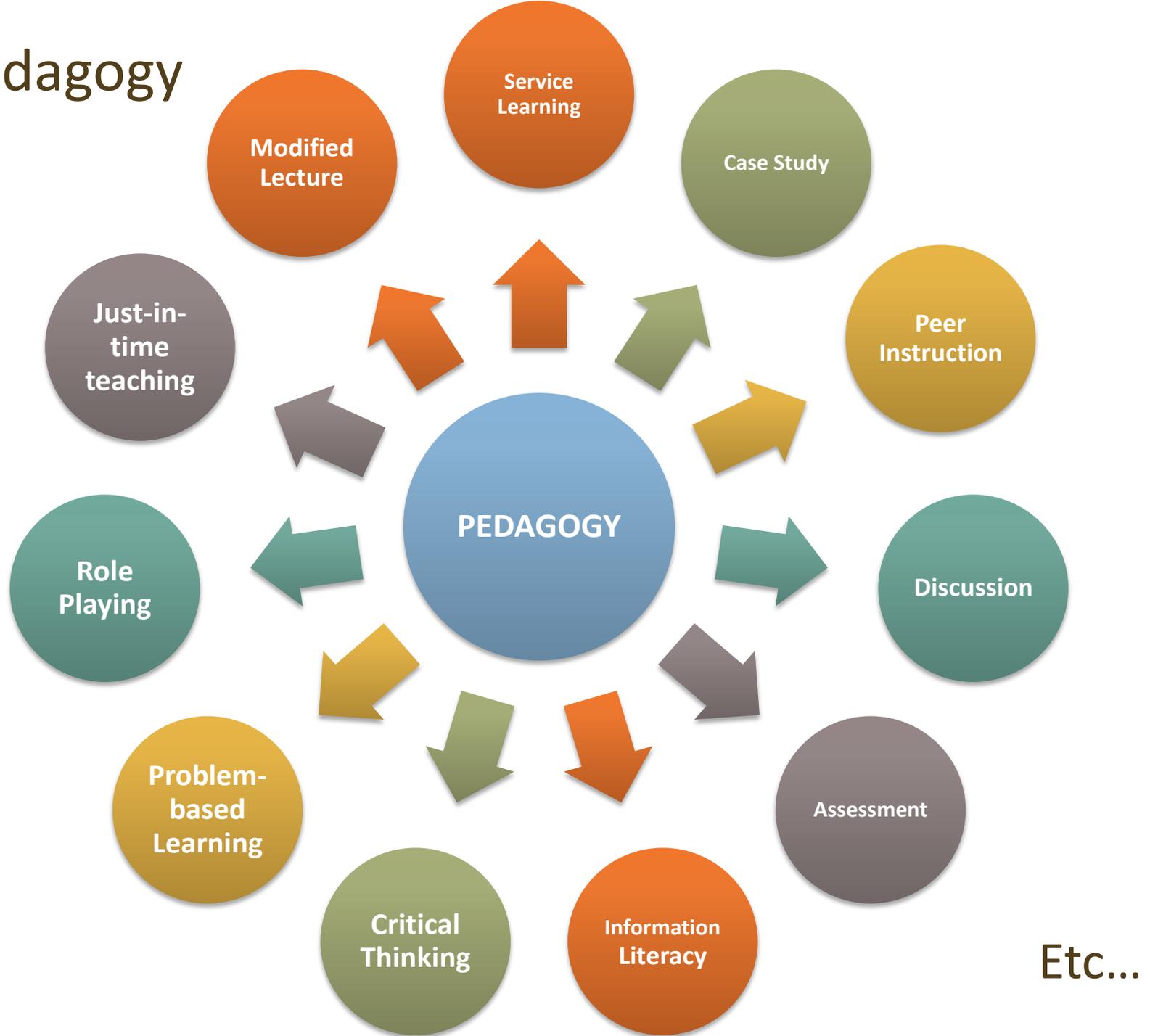
- **Today's employers** prize transferable skills (e.g., problem solving, creativity, interdisciplinary teamwork) over encyclopaedic knowledge.

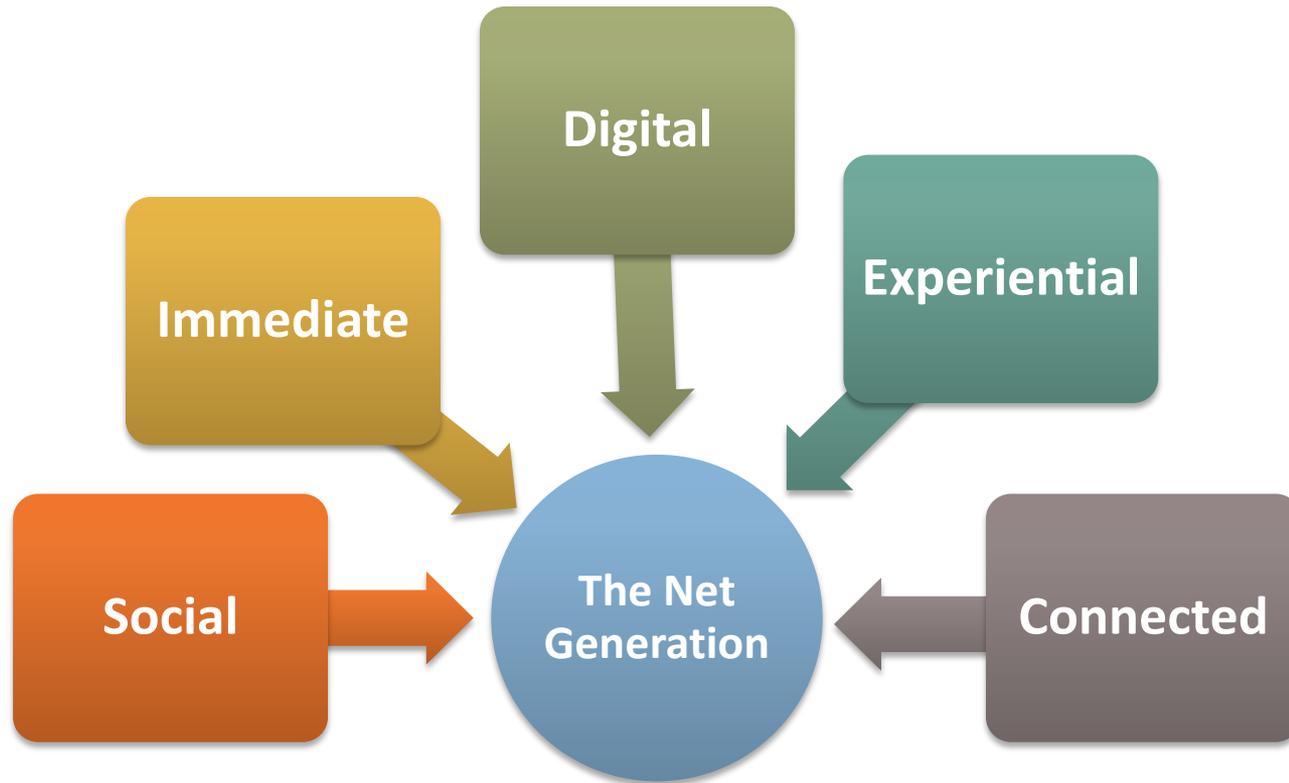

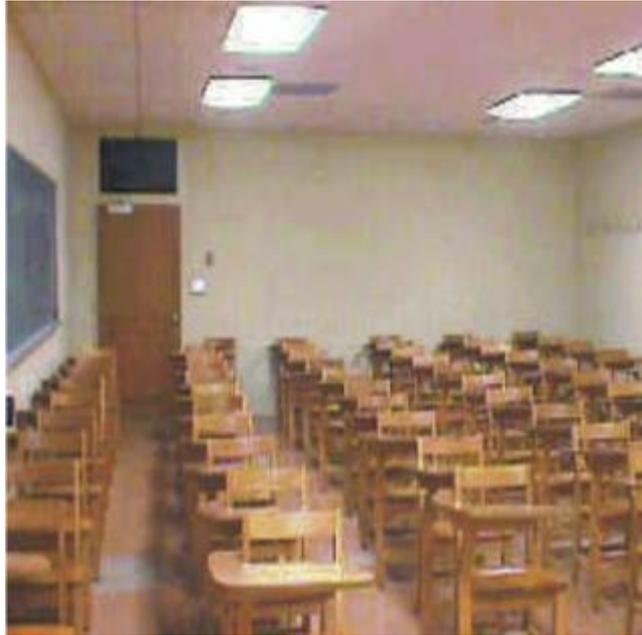
# D. New Learning Spaces

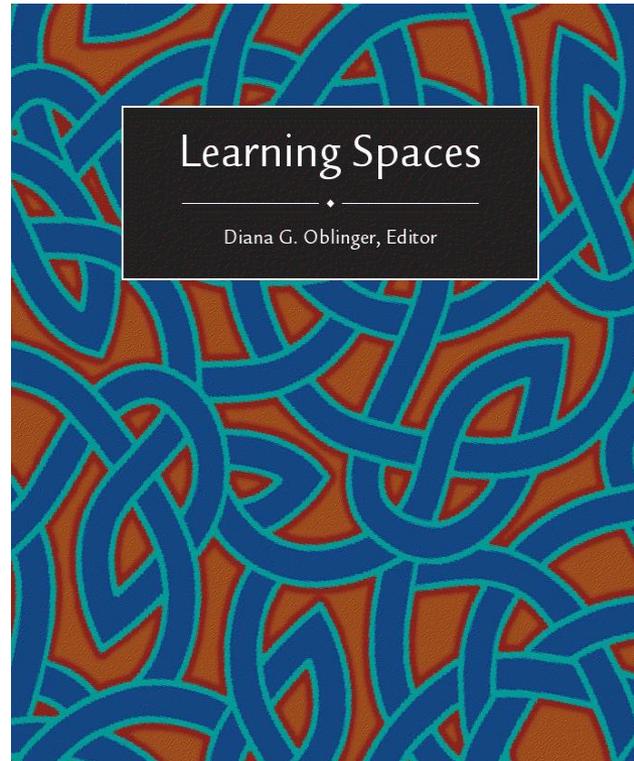

## The Value of a Teaching and Learning Center

One of the most pressing issues in higher education is that of student learning – how to improve, measure, and ensure it. Parents, government officials, and business leaders are demanding that colleges and universities educate their students better, and many institutions have responded by establishing teaching and learning centers. These centers have emphasized the centrality of student learning and have offered support to faculty to become the most effective teachers possible. During the last decade, there has been tremendous growth in centers across the globe: the best private and public research universities have created them, and new centers are burgeoning in comprehensive universities, small liberal arts colleges, and community colleges. The teaching and learning center is a concept whose time has arrived (Cook and Sorcinelli, 2002).

In the spring of 2009, I was invited to the American University in Cairo's Center for Learning and Teaching (CLT) as a visiting scholar. As both a faculty member and academic leader with over twenty-five years of experience in faculty development in the United States and around the world, I had founded two centers at major American research universities and paid visits to countless others. My experience at Egypt's first university teaching center was exceptional. I discovered that CLT is a "jewel

Number of faculty attending



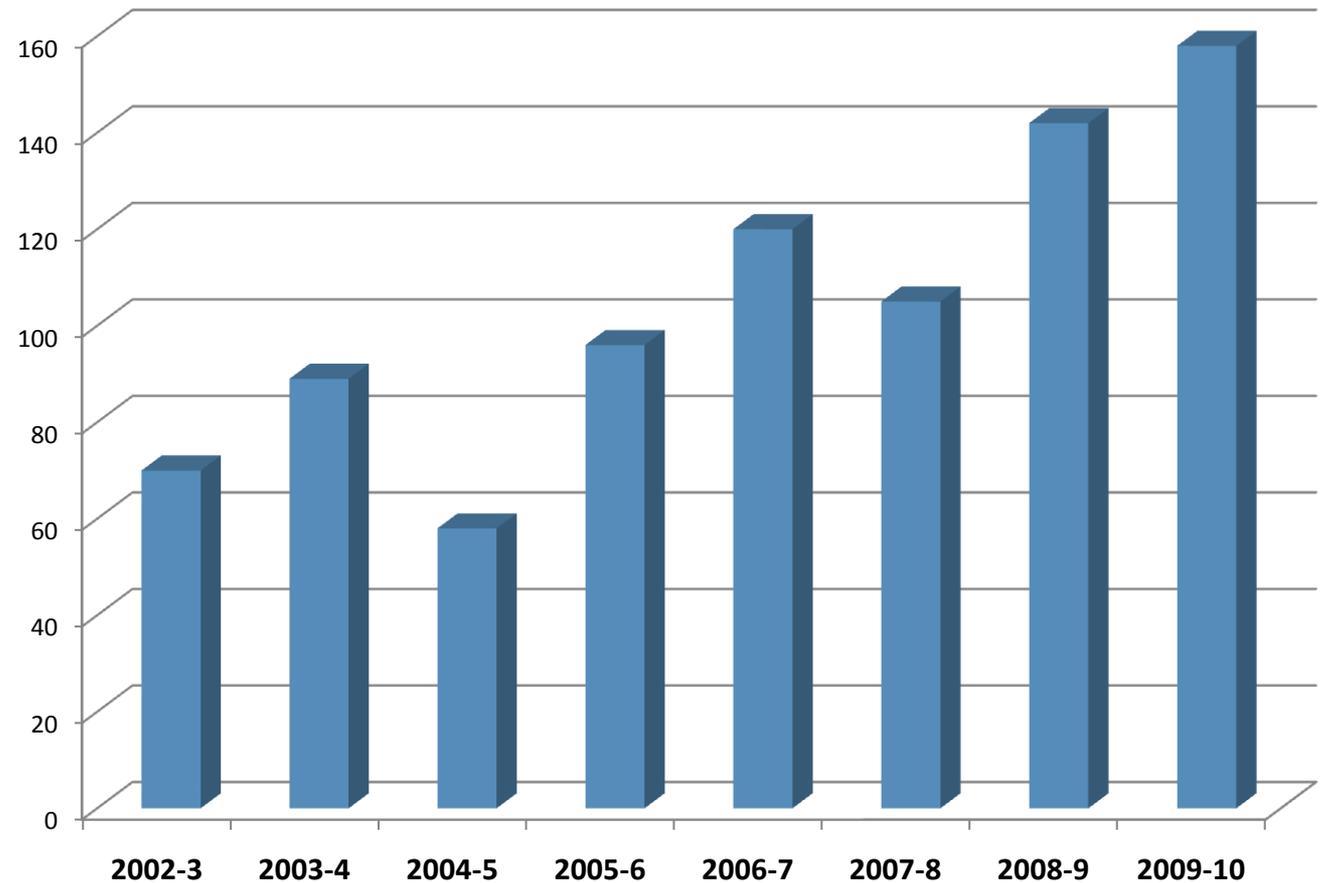

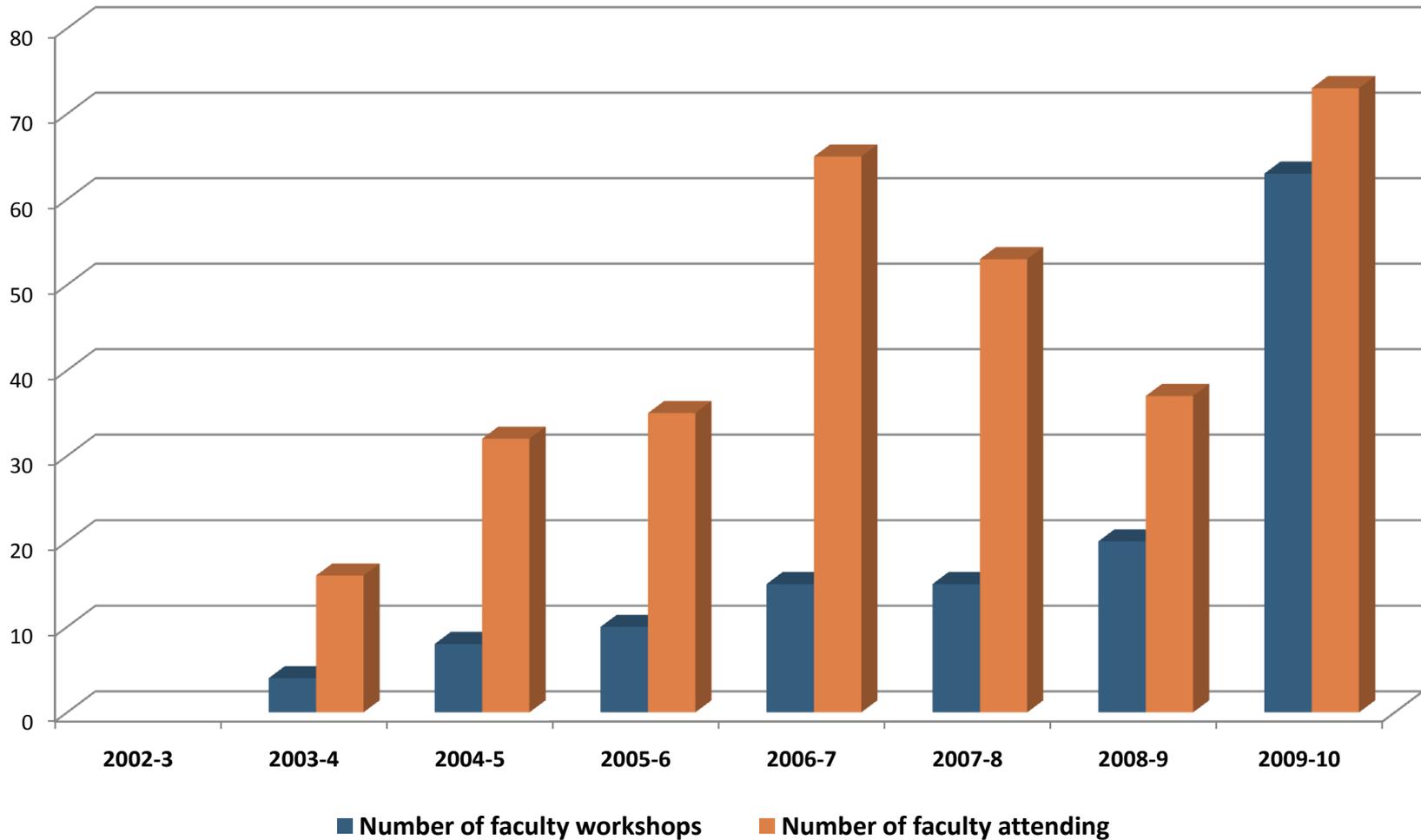

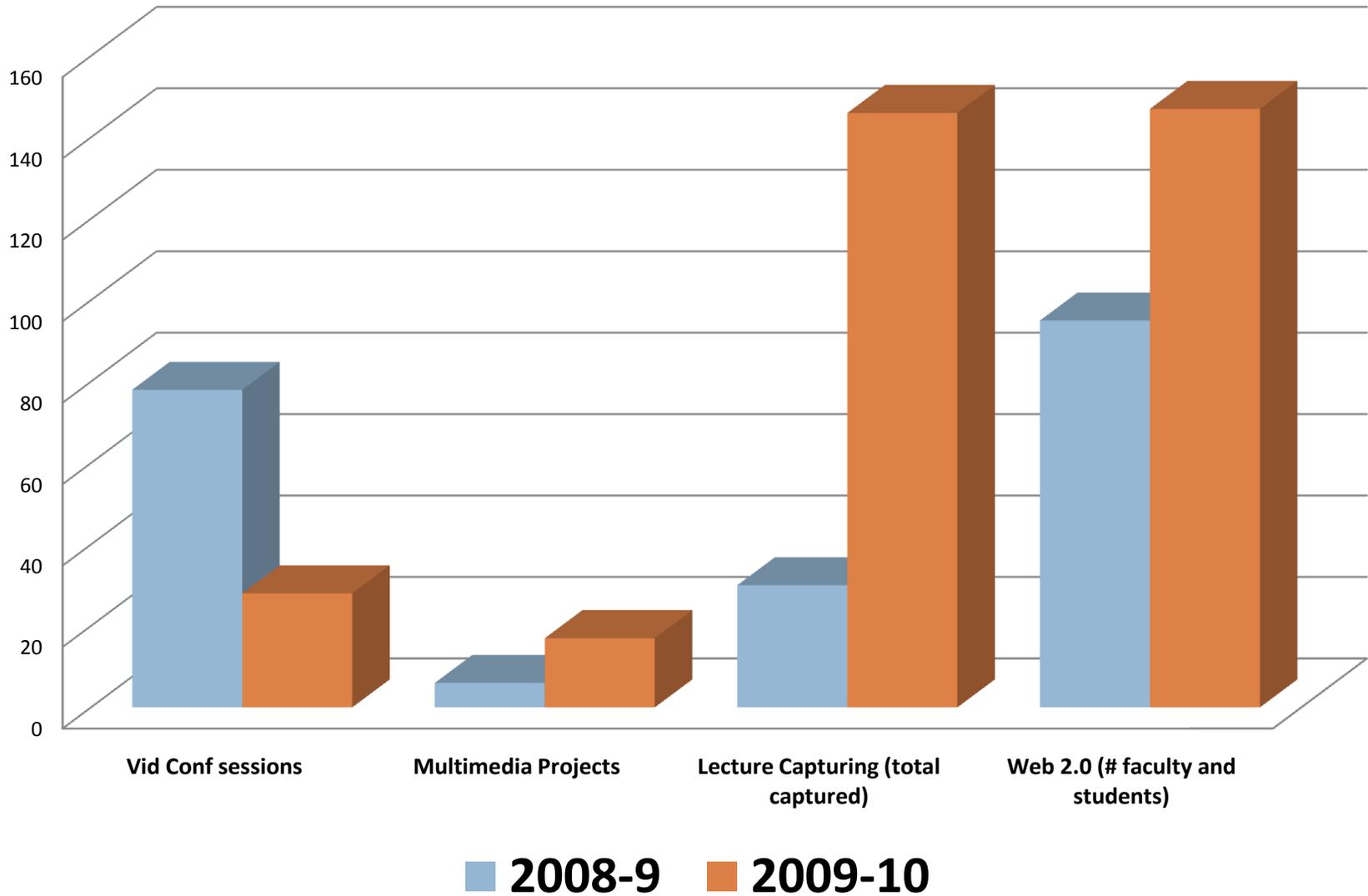
Number of faculty using service



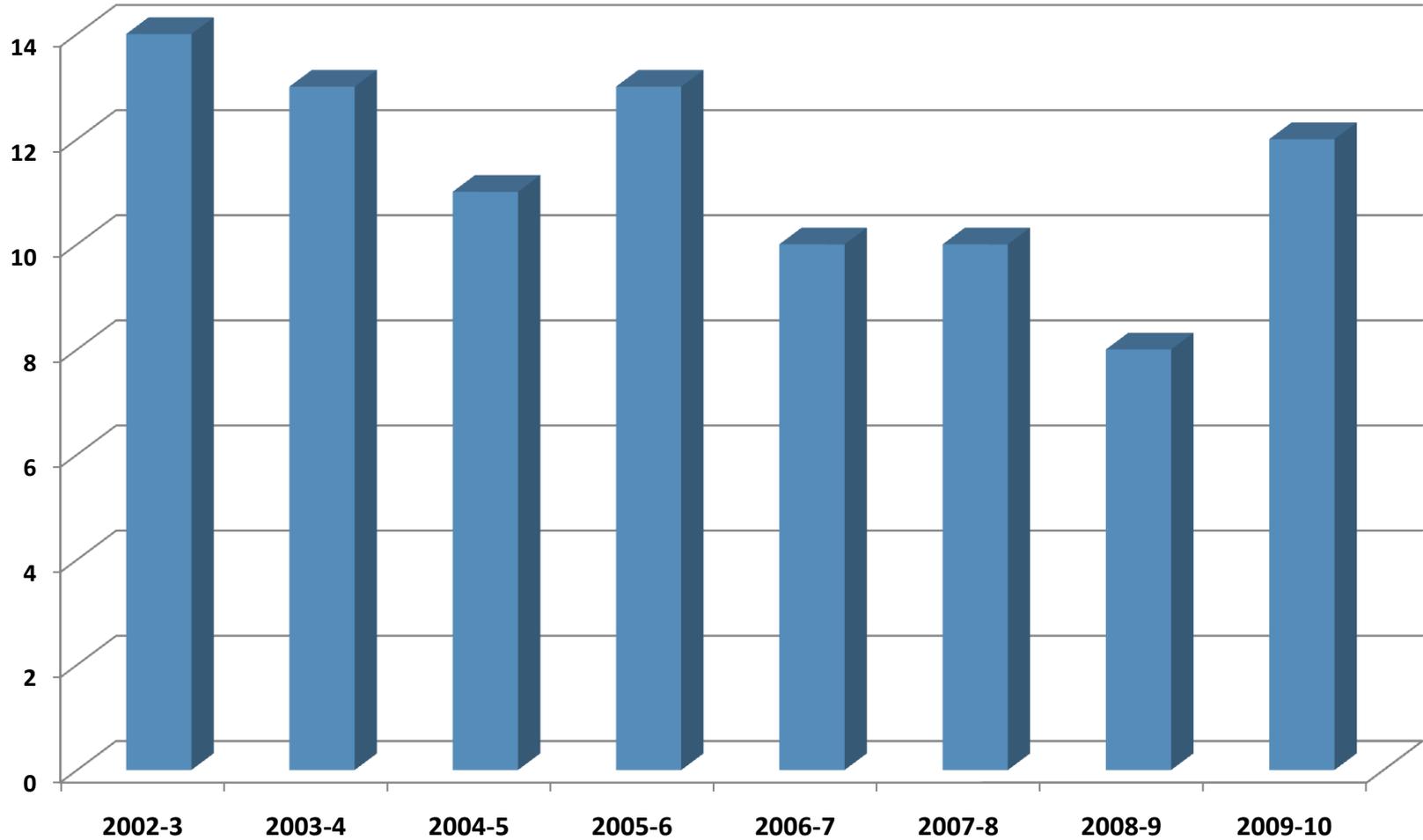
