

The TOEIC Speaking and Writing tests are two separate assessments that can be taken individually, together, or in combination with the TOEIC® Listening and Reading test for an in-depth assessment of all four skills.

Proficiency	Low- to high-level	Low- to high-level
Format	20-minute computer-based test	One-hour computer-based test
Questions	11 questions that require test taker to respond to a spoken and/or written prompt	8 questions that require test taker to respond to a written prompt
Scoring	Total scores range from 0–200 and fall into one of 8 proficiency levels	Total scores range from 0–200 and fall into one of 9 proficiency levels
