¹ Tuition and fees are subject to change.

² This fee includes meals only for students living with host families. Students who opt to live in apartments will incur additional costs for meals.

³ International airfare will vary depending on departure city; academic year students who choose to go home for the semester break will incur the cost of an additional flight.

⁴ This includes an estimated \$500/semester for meals not covered by the room and board charge. This does not include money for extensive personal travel. Students who plan to travel around Jordan or internationally during the term should plan to bring additional funds.

⁵ Students who expect to enroll in the Traditional Islamic Art or Community Based Learning course(s) should plan to spend an additional \$100 - \$150 on class supplies / local transportation per course.

⁶ Housing deposit is only for students living in apartments and is fully refundable at conclusion of semester if apartment is clean and there has been no damage other than normal wear and tear. Housing deposits are due along with tuition and fees (not at the time of the program deposit).

⁷ Only students who opt to live in apartments will incur this additional expense for meals. Actual cost will vary depending on a student's eating habits.

Tuition and fees include:

- Pre-departure preparation
- Courses up to 17 credit
- All-inclusive one-week orientation
- Housing (either with a host family or in a shared apartment)
- Most meals (if with a host family)
- Three program-organized excursions, including one to Petra and Wadi Rum
- Supplementary lectures and special events
- Medical insurance, including medical evacuation and repatriation, and political and security evacuation coverage
- Pre and post program Oral Proficiency Interview
- Program-supplied mobile phone for use in Jordan (usage charges not included)

Tuition and Fees do NOT cover:

- International airfare
- Local personal transportation
- Communication and other personal expenses
- Books or courses materials
- **All meals** if living in a shared apartment
- Visa
- Insurance for student travel prior to or following the official dates of the program
- Medical expenses (including visits to doctors, medical tests, and medications). AMIDEAST recommends students have direct access (e.g. via a debit card or cash) to at least \$300 to pay for any necessary medical expenses while abroad. Should a student expect to see medical professional(s) for on-going physical or mental health issues while abroad, he/she may want to consider bringing more than \$300 for this purpose.
