

Qualified Fulbright applicants who need to enhance their English language skills may be nominated to participate in a Long-Term English (LTE) program before the start of their Fulbright grant.

## **Long-Term English Program Facts**

- You must first apply to the Fulbright Program in order to be nominated to attend an LTE program.
- The Fulbright Program will inform nominees if they are eligible for LTE.
- LTE programs begin in January and March and are six to eight months in duration.
- Dependents cannot accompany LTE grantees.
