- Set up an E-Commerce site to sell online
- Buy an existing business or franchise
- Recruit, hire, train, manage, and motivate employees
- Develop a marketing plan and put it into action
- Use the Internet for online marketing
- Manage purchasing and inventory control
- Prepare for opening the business
- Expand the business and handle problems
- Conduct trade outside Lebanon
