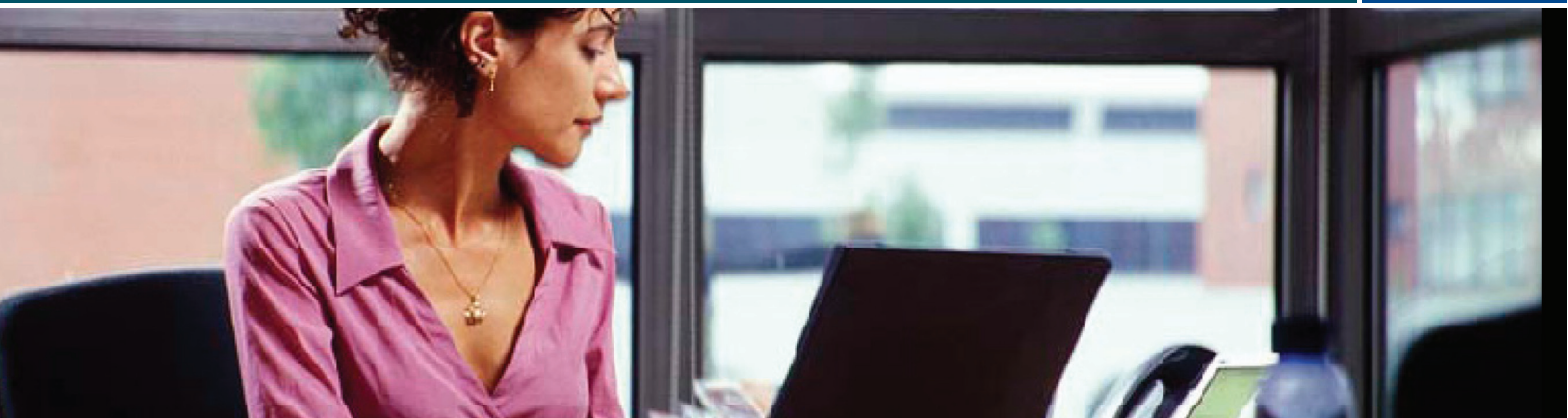

- Describe the importance of change management to the success of your Internet and IT initiative
- Recognize when and how to build a business case
