







Applicants of All English Skill Levels Are Invited to Apply to the Fulbright Program **Long-Term English Program:**

Qualified Fulbright applicants who need to enhance their English language skills may be nominated to participate in a Long-Term English (LTE) program before the start of their Fulbright grant.

Long-Term English Program Facts

- You must first apply to the Fulbright Program in order to be nominated to attend an LTE program.
- The Fulbright Program will inform nominees if they are eligible for LTE.
- LTE programs begin in January and March and are six to eight months in duration.
- Dependents cannot accompany LTE grantees.

LTE Program Benefits:

-  - Improve your English language skills.
-  - Live and study on a U.S. university campus.
-  - Receive full tuition & monthly living stipend.
-  - Increased likelihood of positive U.S. university admissions decisions as a result of increased TOEFL score.
